FROM POINTS NORTH & SOUTH:

From Hartford: Follow I-91 South to Exit 22S (Route 9 South.) Follow Rt. 9 to Exit 16 (Rt. 66) Stay in right hand lane to cross over the Arrigoni Bridge into Portland. At first light, bear right to continue on Rt. 66. Travel approximately 4.5 miles. Saint Clemens entrance will be on the right.

From New London: Follow I-95 South to Old Saybrook. Take Rt. 9 North to Exit 16. Follow Rt. 66 East over the Arrigoni Bridge to Portland. At first light, bear right to continue on Rt. 66. Travel approximately 4.5 miles. Saint Clemens entrance will be on the right.

From Merritt Parkway: Follow Route 15 (Wilbur Cross/Merritt Parkway) North. Take I-91 North to Exit 22S (Rt. 9 South). Follow Rt. 9 to Exit 16 (Rt. 66) Stay in right hand lane to cross over the Arrigoni Bridge into Portland. At first light, bear right to continue on Rt. 66. Travel approximately 4.5 miles. Saint Clemens entrance will be on the right.
