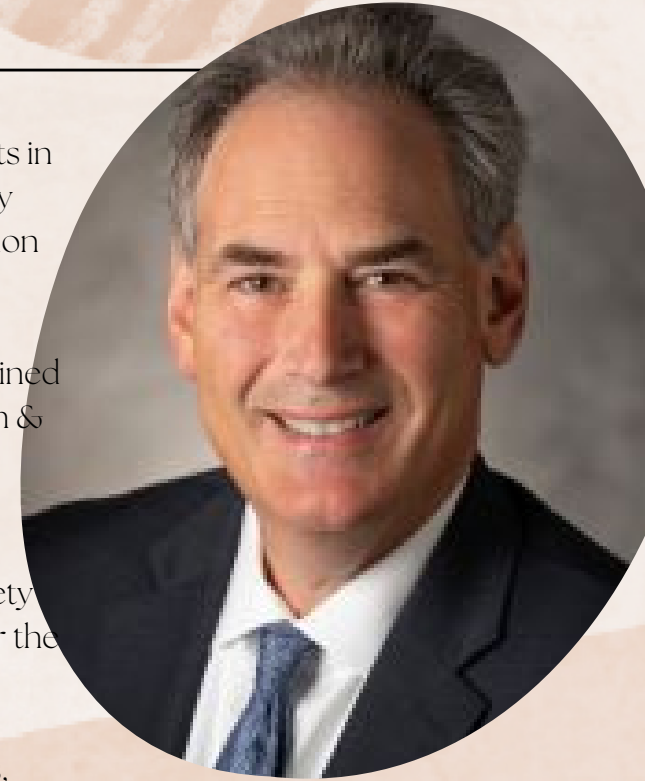


Joshua Teplitzky, JD, CPA, LLM, MBA
